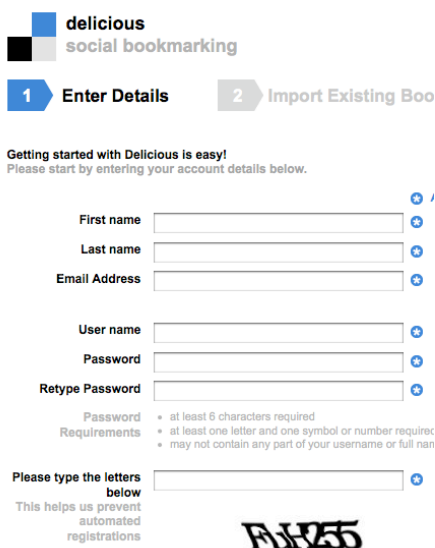
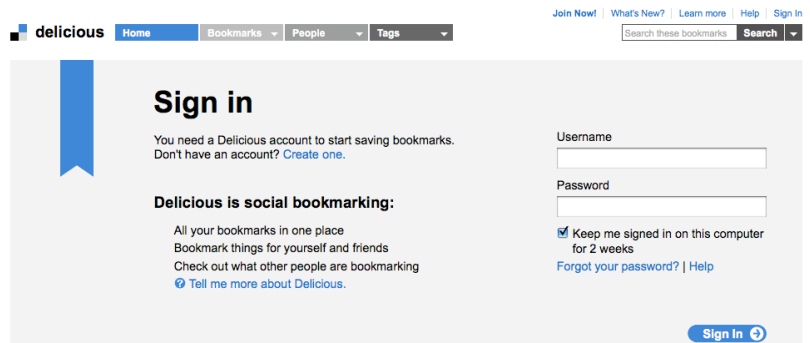


Social Bookmarking

Social bookmarks are a way to keep your web bookmarks or favorites online. Your bookmarks are available any place that you have access to the web.

Social bookmark services enable powerful cross- referencing between bookmark owners, providing opportunities to share and collaborate.



Setting up your *delicious* Account

- 1 **Point your browser to the delicious web site at:** <http://delicious.com/>
- 2 **Click the Join Now** button in the top right corner of the web page.
- 3 **Complete the web form** that asks for a username (no spaces or symbols), your full name, a password (twice), and your e-mail address. You must also type in the code that appears. Then **click Register**.
- 4 An e-mail message will be sent to your mailbox with a hyperlink in it. Click this hyperlink to **verify your account**.

Installing the *delicious* buttons for your Web Browser

- 1 To install delicious buttons **log in to your account** at <http://delicious.com>
- 2 **Click on Help**.
- 3 Go to **Need Tools?**
- 4 Click **Bookmarking buttons and add-ons for your browser or website**
- 5 **Choose your browser** from the list and **follow the installation instructions**.

Browser buttons for saving bookmarks



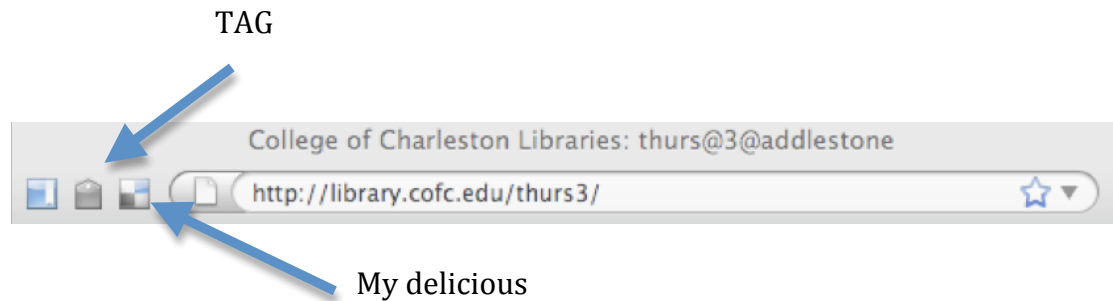
[Firefox Bookmarks add-on](#) – tag buttons and optional integration of your bookmarks

[Internet Explorer buttons](#) – tag buttons and optional integration of your bookmarks

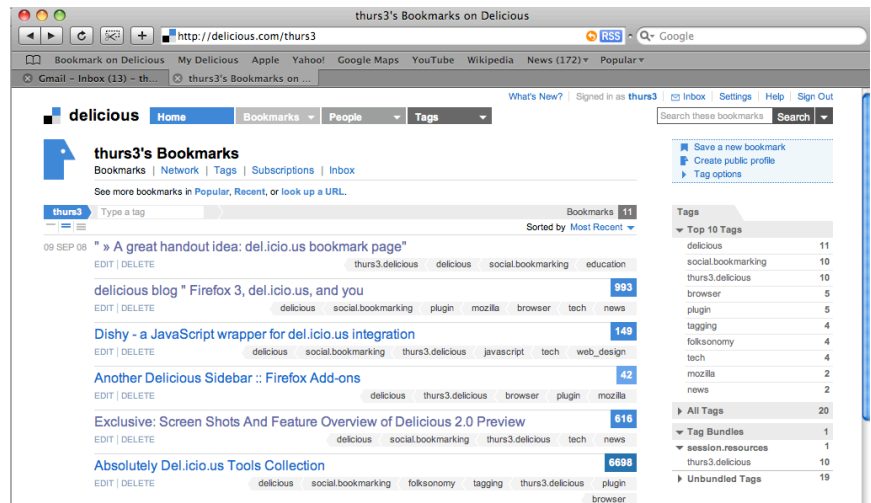
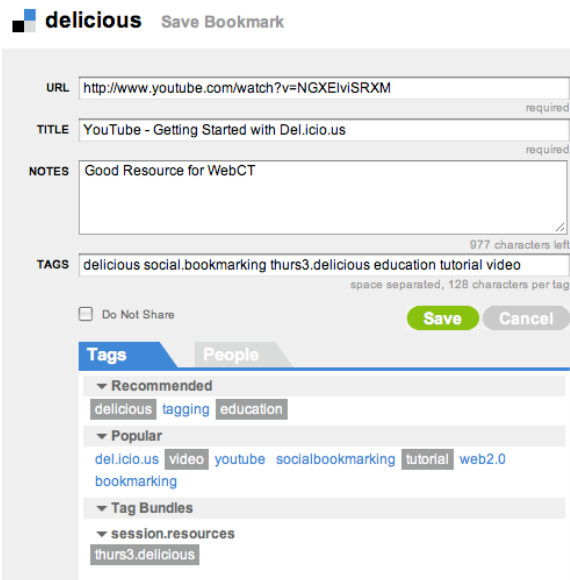
[Bookmarklet buttons for any browser](#) – simple "Bookmark on Delicious" buttons



Adding Bookmarks and Viewing your *delicious* Account



- 1 When you find yourself on a web site you would like to bookmark **click on the TAG or Add to My delicious** button. A new window will pop up.
- 2 **Change the name of the bookmark by editing the description.**
- 3 **Type a note in the notes field** indicating potential uses for the site.
- 4 **Assign** subject categories to the bookmark in the **tags** area.
- 5 If you do not wish to share a bookmark publicly, **you may select** the box beside **do not share**.
- 6 Anyone with access to the Web will be able to **view your list of bookmarks at <http://del.icio.us/yourusernamehere>** . To view the bookmarks you are keeping private, you must be logged into your account.
